## PRESIDENT’S MESSAGE



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NARI of Idaho Members-

Toxic waste repositories; people call them homes but you and I know better. The demolition phase of any remodel brings with it clouds of dust, piles of debris, and a steady stream of black buggers as our respiratory system tries to protect us. In the best cases its only sheetrock dust; a little calcium sulfate in the air. In the worst cases there is vermiculite dust, toxic mold, formaldehyde, asbestos, and the ever present lead. Firefighters wear oxygen masks when entering a burning building primarily because of the toxic brew created as all the materials burn. Yet we as remodelers often work with this same toxic brew wearing only jeans and a t-shirt.

I was at a meeting recently with officials from the city of Boise, HUD, EPA, OSHA, (and Lord only knows who else) discussing lead safe work practices. The EPA had done some random audits of Real Estate offices checking for compliance with lead disclosure rules. Mostly they found compliance, but an interesting remark escaped the lips of one of the city officials: "Have you checked on any contractors? I'll bet that's where you'll find the noncompliance." This was an interesting remark to me. It shows that we as remodelers still are often viewed as nonprofessionals. Its up to those of us who are NARI members to combat this perception.

We can't forget to do the basics. Give your clients a copy of the required lead pamphlet and get a signature showing they have received it. Make dust walls air tight. Keep children away from demolition sites. Cover dumpsters or debris piles that could generate wind-born dust. Use a dust mask or respirator. Throw your clothes in the washing machine as soon as you get home, do not stop to kiss your sweetheart or hug your kids. Take a lead safe training course when its offered. Clean up at the end of the day. Clean up at the end of the job. Clean up some more.

Our nation has inherited a legacy of toxic homes. Its our job as NARI contractors to be the first line of defense against those toxins. Its what makes us professionals, its what sets us apart, its why people choose to hire us. Its up to us to prove the city official wrong.

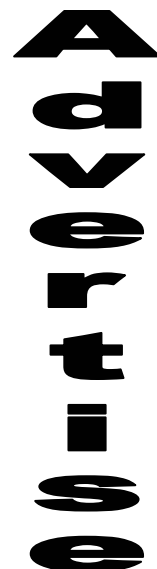
